Stephen Law received his PhD in Economics from the University of Toronto in 1997. He has held faculty positions at the University of New Brunswick and Ryerson University and is currently Professor of Economics at Mount Allison University where he teaches courses in Industrial Organization, Law & Economics, International Trade, and Health Economics. He has published research papers in journals such as the *Canadian Journal of Economics*, *Canadian Public Policy*, *Applied Economics*, and the *Review of Industrial Organization* on a wide range of topics including regulatory economics; intellectual property rights and competition policy; pharmacist behavior; pharmaceutical formularies; real options analysis in the rail industry; nutrient price indexes and food taxation; and the economics of the telecommunications and re-broadcasting sector. His research interests are in applied microeconomics, particularly the

study of regulatory policy. Stephen Law was appointed to the Canadian Competition Tribunal in April 2019.
