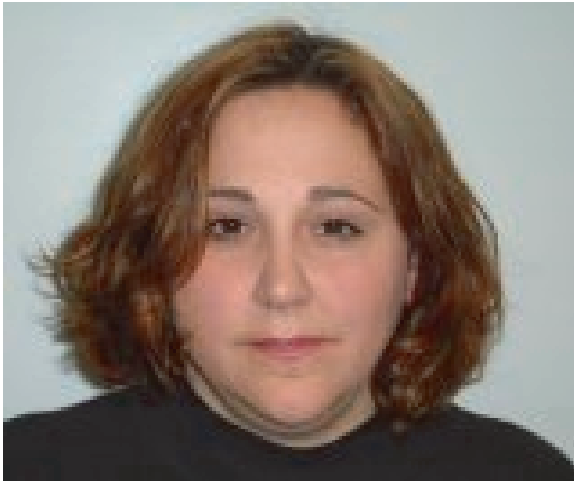


Linda St-Pierre

Linda St Pierre is currently serving her sixth consecutive term as LUFA's elected Chief Steward, having been first elected on July 1, 2009. Linda has also held the full-time position of Chief Grievance Officer since that position was created in 2012, while still maintaining her elected status as Chief Steward.

Linda has been teaching in the Behavioural Neuroscience Program at Laurentian as a sessional faculty member since 1999, and has pursued research in the field.

She obtained her PhD in Integrative Biological Sciences from the University of Guelph in 2011 .

Linda has co-authored over thirty articles in refereed journals and continues to be active as a sessional Laurentian faculty Member teaching in both the Neuroscience and Labour Studies programs.

Linda played a pivotal role in collective bargaining for LUFA having been actively involved in nine bargaining teams over the past decade. She also led three certification drives, for online instructors, clinicians working on campus and at the hospital.

Over the last decade, she has filed several hundred grievances, and participated in countless mediation sessions and arbitration hearings.
